

# COURSE IN SPECIALIST BODY PIERCING

## 10019NAT

This course is specific, in-depth, comprehensive and relevant.

It incorporates nationally recognised course HLTIN402C Maintain Infection Control in Office Practice Settings.

**Course in Specialist Body Piercing has four units;**

- HLTIN402C Maintain Infection Control in Office Practice Settings
- SIBBSKS505A Provide Upper Body Piercing
- SBPSBP001A Provide Specialist Body Piercing
- SBPCAP002A Provide clinical advice for body piercing

All of the units are designed to train you to safely offer body piercing in a professional clinic and have a thorough understanding of sterilization and cross-contamination issues. With this qualification you may seek employment in any health field or set up your own practice in body piercing.

There is extensive pre and post contact reading and assignments to be completed as well as compulsory attendance at the five days of face to face contact training time. You will be required to research and have knowledge of State legislation and regulations relevant to the State you are working in.

We train in small groups to allow your every question to be answered and your practical to be closely supervised.

### **Prerequisites**

Rules surrounding this course, require that you have a certificate of first aid training before commencing 10019NAT Course in Specialist Body Piercing.

Eze Training need to have evidence to support you have completed first aid training.

This means you must have a certificate which lists:

HLTAID002 Provide Basic Emergency Life Support

Or

HLTAID003 - Provide First Aid

If you do not have a certificate, Eze Training recommends you enrol into a course for First Aid.

**This course has five days of contact time.** This course offers training at the highest level, relevant assessments and a Statement of Attainment is issued by a Eze Training Pty Ltd when an individual has completed one or more accredited units. Students cover all upper body piercing sites both in theory & practice as well as legal, safety, sterilization, record keeping & business practice.

The nominal hours for the course are 135hrs.

### **Assessment Information**

The assessments for this course require satisfactory completion of:

1. Research, written questions and answers from Workbook 1 – 5
2. Written questions and answers from Workbook 6 -11
3. Multiple choice and written questions in Assessment Paper
4. Demonstration of skills and knowledge - four (4) practical observations of piercing , including 1 micro dermal piercing
5. Self Reflection Log

Written assignments, tests and demonstrations means you will be required to demonstrate the skills and knowledge you have learnt during the course. You will be advised in advance when your assessment will take place.

Timeframes for completion of assessments are:

#### **Workbook and Assessment Material**

Research, written questions and answers from Workbook 1 – 5	4 hours
Written questions and answers from Workbook 6 -11	4 hours
Multiple choice and written questions in Assessment Paper	2 hours
Demonstration of skills and knowledge- four (4) practical observations of piercing , including 1 micro dermal piercing	30 mins for each piercing

All information and answers must be deemed satisfactory by the assessor. The assessor may ask you to clarify some information you have written to confirm your knowledge. Allowing more time to complete the assessment will be considered by the assessor on a case by case basis.

Materials required for the written assessment are pens and paper and the assessor will supply any other resources to ensure you are able to complete the written sections correctly.

You will be required to demonstrate your skills to the assessor, who will complete a checklist while you perform specific treatments relating to this course. The conditions you will be undertaking the assessment in are similar to that of the workplace. The assessor may ask you to demonstrate a particular skill more than once, however, if the skill to be demonstrated cannot be completed to a satisfactory level on the second time, he may choose to stop the assessment.

Materials required for the demonstration of skills are listed in the body piercing pack, which is listed below and is found in the workroom where your demonstration of skills will take place.

Your assessor will provide you with feedback at the end of your assessment. In the event you are not successful in achieving a competent outcome, your assessor will discuss with you any further training required and will organise another assessment to be conducted at a date and time suitable to both parties.

### **Assessment Outcomes 10019NAT Course in Specialist Body Piercing**

#### **Satisfactory Outcome**

- A Satisfactory outcome will be recorded by the assessor when the student has successfully completed assessment tasks in:
  - ✓ Workbook multiple choice and short questions and answers 1 – 5
  - ✓ Workbook multiple choice and short questions and answers 6 - 11
  - ✓ Assessment paper questions and answers
  - ✓ Four (4) Practical demonstration observation conducted in real or simulated workplace.
  - ✓ Submission of Self Reflection log book

#### **Not Satisfactory Outcome**

- Where the student has not fulfilled the requirements after two (2) attempts, a result of not satisfactory will be recorded by the assessor. The assessor will provide feedback to the

student and further training will be organised at a time which suits both the student and assessor.

- It is the assessor's responsibility to work with the student and assist them with any additional training that maybe required following this assessment task to ensure that they are prepared for reassessment.

#### **Reassessment of Assessment Task**

- In the event the overall outcome of the assessment is Not Satisfactory, the student will have the opportunity to be reassessed. Reassessment can be undertaken immediately, after further training or within 2 weeks of the original Not Satisfactory Outcome. No Fee will be charged.

- The assessor will record the final outcome of Competent on the Assessment Instrument Record Check List, located at the end of the observation/demonstration checklist tool.
- When a competent result is recorded, a Statement of Attainment will be issued to the student.
- Where the student has not fulfilled the requirements after two attempts, a result of not competent will be recorded.

#### **Not Competent Outcome**

- Not Competent will be recorded in the event the student cannot satisfactorily demonstrate the knowledge and skills required to meet the course outcomes.
- If the requirements are not met the assessor will provide feedback to the student and where identified, further training will be provided.
- The assessor will record the further training required by the student. Further training can be in the form of one on one support by the trainer, through telephone, email or face to face support.
- It is the assessor's responsibility to work with the student and assist them with any additional training that maybe required following an assessment, to ensure that they are prepared for reassessment
- When a Not Competent result is recorded, a Statement of Attainment WILL NOT be issued to the student.
